

November 19, 1964 - Found 1" iron pipe up 2' and 5.80' east of 1/4 corner according to area resurvey. Replaced found iron pipe with 1" x 10' red and white iron pipe. Established ties to red and white iron pipe.

January 15, 1974 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

November, 16 1999 - Found red and white iron pipe, established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods and updated ties.

August 23, 2006 - Found red and white iron pipe broken off (up 0.5'). Updated ties.

July 2, 2014 - Found red and white iron pipe in need of replacement. Verified position by VRS GPS methods.

September 17, 2014 - Found broken iron pipe and replaced with a 2" x 6' square steel Telspar with punchmarked cap using static GPS methods. Verified position by VRS GPS methods and updated ties.

January 11, 2022 - Found 2" x 6' square steel Telspar with punchmarked cap, verified position by VRS GPS methods and updated ties.
