

December 1956 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

September 10, 1963 - Found 4" square concrete monument up 0.5' using Harvey A. Cartwright 1948 ties. Updated ties.

September 23, 1981 - Found concrete monument leaning slightly. Straightened and updated ties.

June 11, 1986 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

August 8, 1990 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

July 24, 1995 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

August 24, 1999 - Found concrete monument, established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods and updated ties.

May 21, 2014 - Found concrete monument up 1'±, leaning and in need of reset.

July 29, 2014 - Found concrete monument and replaced with a 2" x 7' square steel Telspar monument with cap and punchmark up 1'± using static GPS methods. Updated ties.

June 11, 2019 - Found 2" square steel Telspar monument up 3'± and updated ties.

May 12, 2022 - Found 2" square steel Telspar monument up 3'±, verified position by GPS VRS method and updated ties.
