

CORNER HISTORY:

December 28, 1944 - Cartwright found concrete monument down 0.3' and established ties to monument.

May 7, 1963 - Found 4" x 4" concrete monument down 0.3'. Set a 2.5' iron pipe up 1' on the North side. Updated ties.

September 14, 1964 - Found 4" x 4" concrete monument and updated ties.

August 14, 1968 - Found 4" x 4" concrete monument and updated ties.

January 6, 1978 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

August 3, 1995 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

February 9, 2000 - Found concrete monument, established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods and updated ties.

July 24, 2014 - Found concrete monument partially broken and in need of reset. Checked position against corner ties.

September 12, 2014 - Found broken concrete monument and replaced with a 2" x 8' square steel Telspar monument with punchmarked cap using static GPS methods. Set sign and post on North side and updated ties.

January 11, 2022 - Found 2" x 8' square steel Telspar monument with punchmarked cap, verified position by VRS GPS method. Updated ties.
