

CORNER HISTORY:

January 20, 1966 - Nothing found at location. Set 1/2" x 10' red and white iron pipe up 3' using MNDOT angles and distances from Interstate 35E right of way plat. Established ties to iron pipe.

July 15, 1970 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

January 15, 1974 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

August 10, 1976 - Found red and white iron pipe bent and ties gone due to power line construction.

February 6, 1978 - Found red and white iron pipe bent and ties gone due to power line construction.

February 12, 1979 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties. Pipe position fit well with section closure.

August 14, 1985 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

June 13, 1990 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

August 21, 1995 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

January 17, 2006 - Found red and white iron pipe. Updated ties. Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

June 16, 2023 - Found 1 1/2" pipe bent and laying down. Replaced monument with 2" square Telspar with punched cap set up 0.5'± set to published coordinates using ACS RTK GPS method. Updated ties after setting. Sign and post added to East side, facing West.
