

CORNER HISTORY:

April 23, 1943 - H. A. Cartwright found granite monument down 10" with iron pipe on East side in centerline of Main Street. Established ties to monument.

August 9, 1955 - C.E. Coulter found granite monument down 3.5' in centerline of Main Street. Set iron pipe flush with surface and updated ties.

September 18, 1957 - Minnesota Highway Department found iron pipe down 0.1' in centerline of Main Street. Updated ties.

November 1959 - N.C. Hoium set iron pipe and updated ties.

August 16, 1960 - Found granite monument down 4'. Set cast iron monument on top of granite and flush with surface. Updated ties.

June 29, 1964 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 20, 1966 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 23, 1970 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties. Set P.K. nails 2.00' North and East.

July 19, 1974 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 17, 1977 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 26, 1980 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 25, 1983 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 24, 1986 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 7, 1990 - Set construction (transit) ties prior to road construction.

November 27, 1990 - Set cast iron monument flush after road construction using construction ties. Established temporary ties.

June 25, 1991 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 8, 1994 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

September 28, 2001 - Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

March 25, 2010 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

April 29, 2015 - Found broken cast iron monument down 0.7'. Verified location with VRS GPS methods.

April 30, 2020 - Removed broken monument and replaced with a new cast iron monument. Updated ties

June 5, 2023 - Found cast iron monument flush, verified position by ACS RTK GPS method and updated ties.
