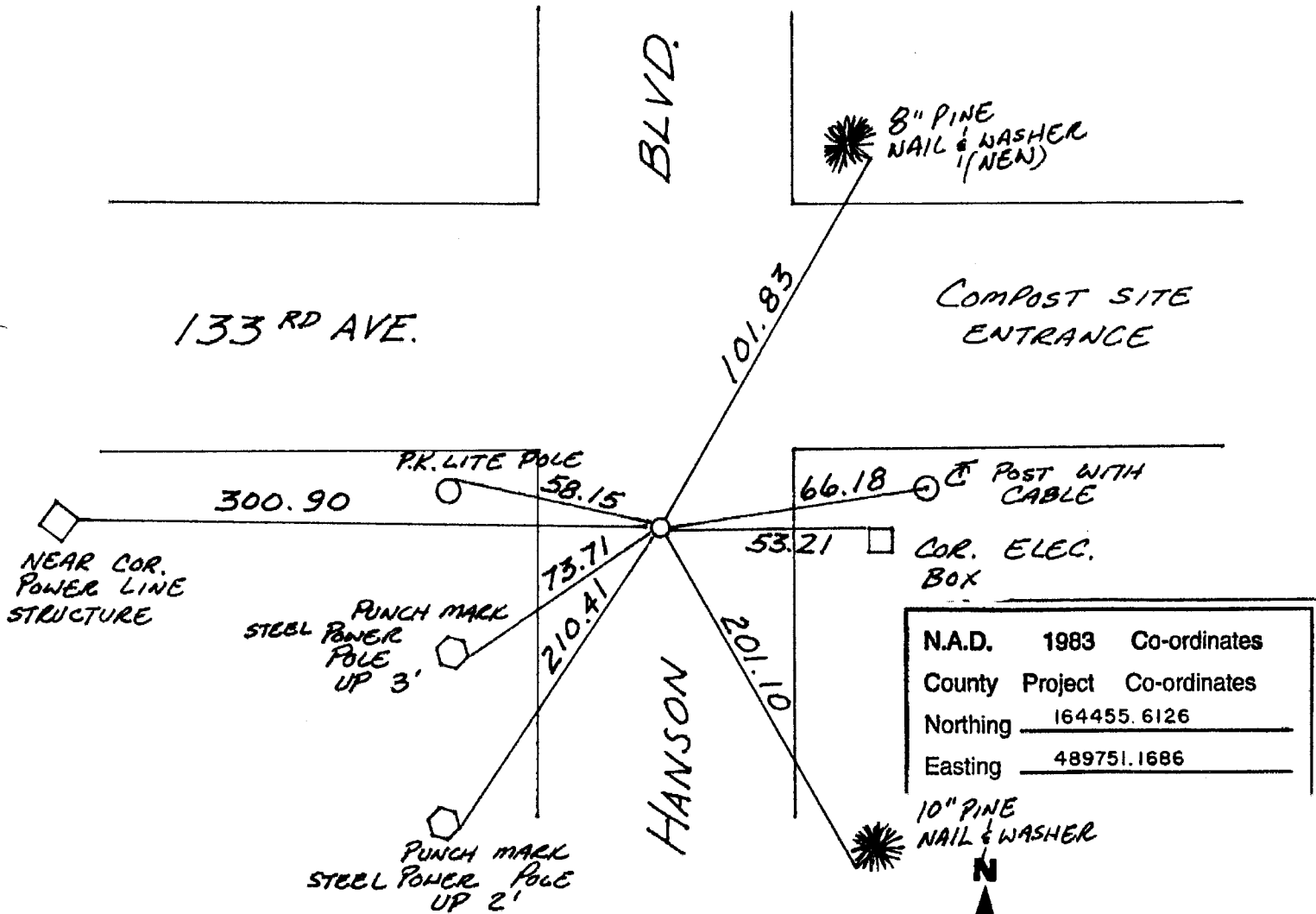

and I further certify that to perpetuate the location of said corner, I did, at the exact location thereof, place a permanent marker consisting of CAST IRON MON.

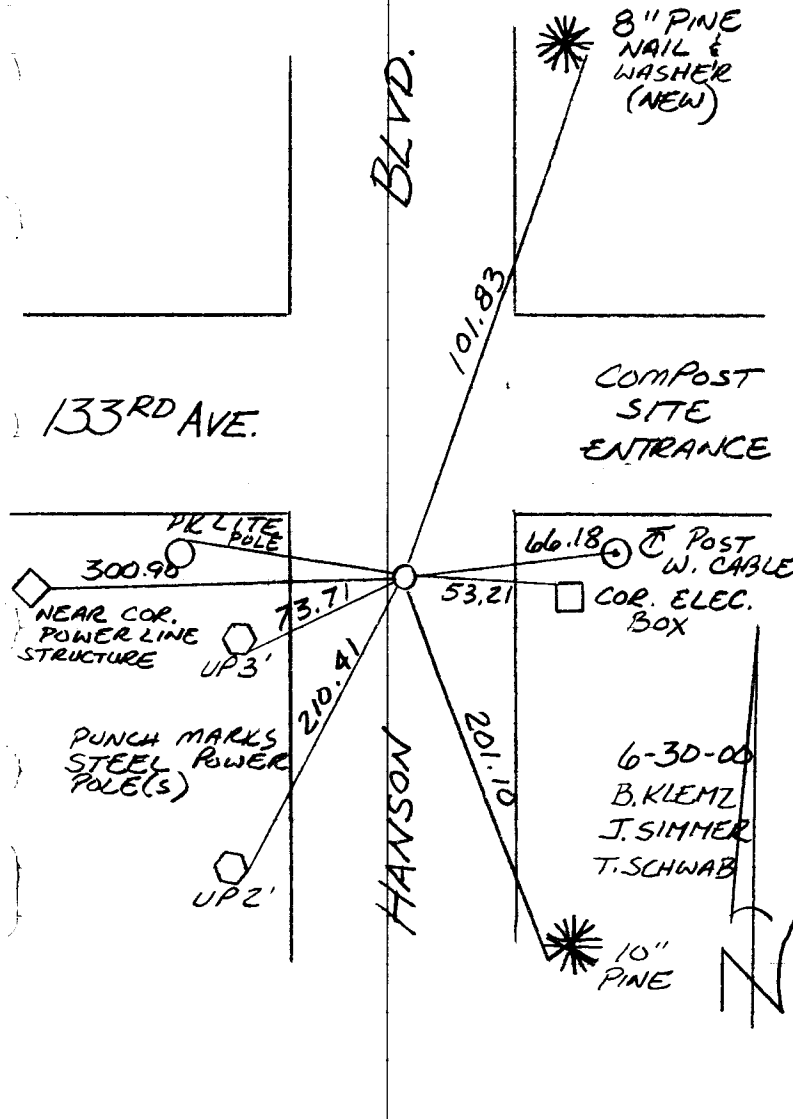

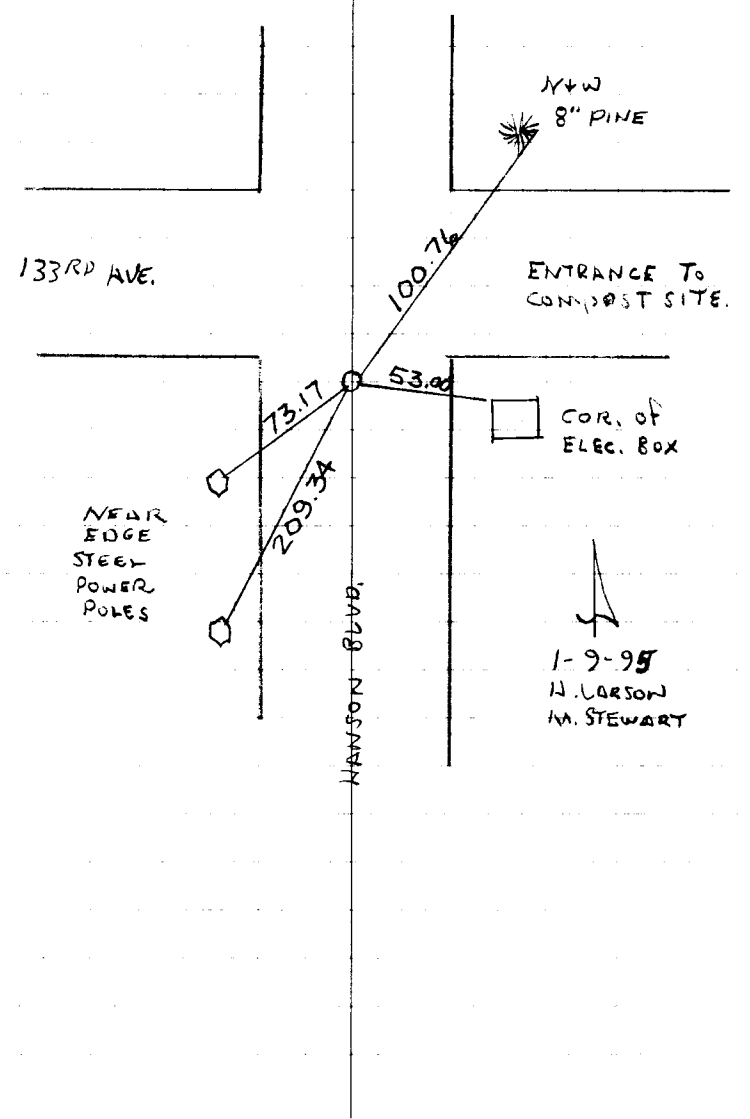

RETIED CAST IRON MONUMENT.

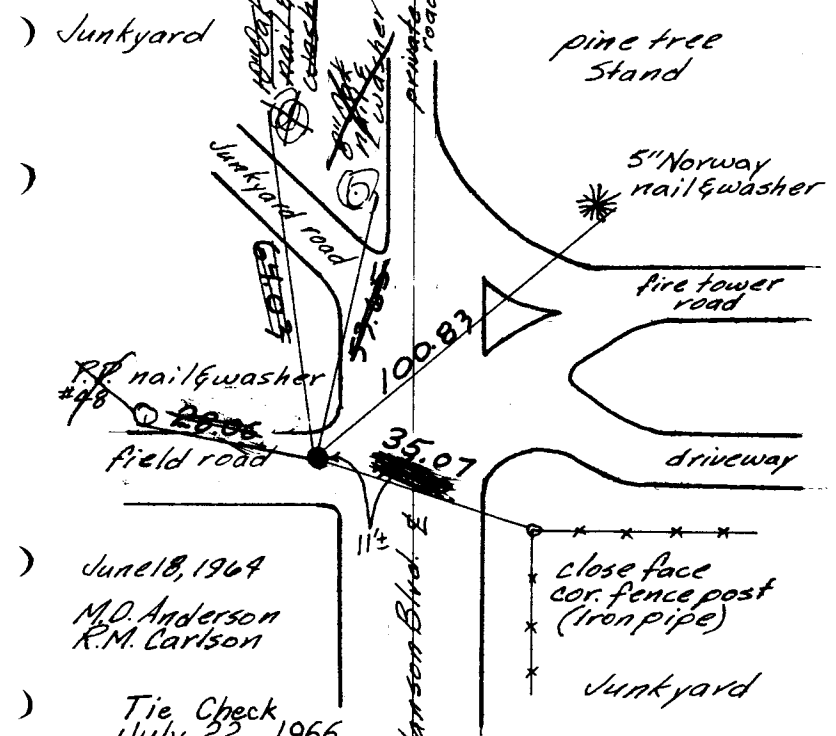

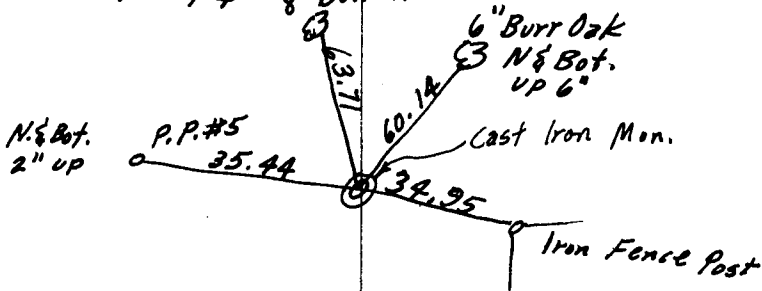

rotted wood stakes beside iron.
