CORNER HISTORY:

April 14, 1943 - H.A. Cartwright found concrete monument flush with surface. Established ties to monument.

August 9, 1955 - C.E. Coulter found concrete monument flush with surface on side slope and 16.5' north of centerline Updated ties.

February 17, 1960 - Found concrete monument flush with surface on slope of road and updated ties.

March 25, 1964 - Set construction (transit) ties to concrete monument prior to road construction.

November 18, 1964 - Set P.K. nail after road construction using construction ties. Set P.K. nails 2.00' North and East of corner position.

November 4, 1966 - Replaced P.K. nail with a cast iron monument set flush with surface and updated ties. Monument is 4'± south of centerline.

July 23, 1970 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 2, 1974 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties. Set P.K.nails 2' North and West of monument.

June 15, 1977 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 25, 1980 - Found cast iron monument flush with surface and updated ties.

June 16, 1986 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 21, 1990 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 18, 1994 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 7, 2001 - Found cast iron monument and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

March 17, 2010 - Found cast iron monument flush with surface and updated ties.
