CORNER HISTORY:

December 15, 1944 - Found U.S. Bearing Tree, an 18" rotten stump with old square nail driven into it up 16". No information given as to what is set in the corner position.

August 2, 1960 - Found concrete monument down 0.2' with an iron pipe on the north side and updated ties.

June 16, 1964 - Found concrete monument and updated ties. Iron pipe could not be found.

July 22, 1966 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

July 21, 1970 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

July 3, 1974 - Replaced concrete monument with a cast iron monument set down 0.1' and updated ties.

June 16, 1977 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 20, 1980 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

October 9, 1986 - Updated ties and removed cast iron monument prior to construction. Set 1/2" iron pipe in location of monument.

January 19, 1988 - Found 1/2" iron pipe and updated ties.

August 14, 1990 - Found 1/2" iron pipe and updated ties.

August 17, 1994 - Found 1/2" iron pipe and updated ties.

February 23, 1995 - Found 1/2" iron pipe and updated ties.

August 10, 2001 - Found 1/2" iron pipe and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods.

February 8, 2010 - Found 1/2" iron pipe and updated ties.
