CORNER HISTORY:

May 2, 1944 - H.A. Cartwright found 3/4" brass plug set down 0.1' in highway. Established ties to monument.

October 7, 1958 - Don Coulter found 3/4" brass plug down 0.1'. Updated ties.

August 1, 1960 - Found 1" round brass plug flush with the surface and updated ties.

July 14, 1966 - Found 1" round brass plug flush with the surface and updated ties.

July 28, 1970 - Replaced 1" round brass plug with a broken off cast iron monument set flush with the surface. Set P.K. Nails 2.00' north and east and updated ties.

July 1, 1974 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 21, 1977 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 3, 1980 - Found cast iron monument down 0.5' and retied after construction. Position verified by plats of Larson 2nd Addition, Sundquist Addition and Cardinal Heights Plat 4.

July 20, 1983 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 17, 1986 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 30, 1990 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 19, 1994 - Replaced cast iron monument with a new cast iron monument. Updated ties.

August 30, 2001 - Found cast iron monument and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

March 15, 2010 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.
