August 10, 1960 - Found concrete monument and set four iron pipe stradles for correct location.

August 24, 1960 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

March 15, 1963 - Found concrete monument with an iron pipe on the east side and updated ties.

June 5, 1964 - Found concrete monument down 0.5' with an iron pipe on the east side and updated ties.

July 13, 1966 - Found concrete monument down 0.5' with an iron pipe on the east side and updated ties.

August 3, 1970 - Found concrete monument with an iron pipe on the east side and updated ties.

July 12, 1974 - Replaced broken off concrete monument with cast iron monument set down 0.2'±. Updated ties.

June 21, 1977 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 7, 1980 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 14, 1990 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 16, 1994 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

October 11, 2001 - Found cast iron monument and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

March 24, 2010 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.
