CORNER HISTORY:

June 5, 1943 - H.A. Cartwright found concrete monument set flush with the surface. Established ties to monument.

July 1955 - Minder Engineering Company found concrete monument and updated ties.

September 28, 1959 - N.C. Hoium found concrete monument with top broken off and an iron pipe on the south side. Updated ties.

February 24, 1960 - Found concrete monument broken off down 8" and an iron pipe on the north side. Updated ties.

June 4, 1964 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

July 12, 1966 - Found concrete monument and updated ties.

July 30, 1970 - Found concrete monument and set broken off cast iron monument flush with the surface on top of concrete monument. Updated ties.

July 12, 1974 - Found cast iron monument leaning and concrete monument broken in several places. Replaced with new cast iron monument set down 0.5'± and updated ties. There is a buried cable under top of monument on north side.

June 22, 1977 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 10, 1980 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 25, 1983 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

March 7, 1984 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 23, 1986 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

April 26, 1991 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 11, 1994 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

October 24, 2001 - Found cast iron monument and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

March 23, 2010 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.
