CORNER HISTORY:

July 31, 1944 - H.A. Cartwright found concrete monument down 3". Established ties to monument.

August 2, 1960 - Found concrete monument with an iron pipe on the north side and updated ties.

June 8, 1964 - Found concrete monument down 0.3' with an iron pipe on the north side and updated ties.

July 14, 1966 - Found concrete monument with an iron pipe on the north side and updated ties.

July 22, 1970 - Found concrete monument down 0.2'± with an iron pipe on the north side and updated ties.

July 1, 1974 - Replaced concrete monument down 0.2'± and iron pipe on north side with a cast iron monument set up 1'± and set sign and post 1'± north of monument. Updated ties.

June 8, 1977 - Raised cast iron monument to a position flush with surface and updated ties. Sign and post on the north side of monument.

June 25, 1980 - Found cast iron monument updated ties.

July 19, 1983 - Found cast iron monument updated ties.

November 9, 1983 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 18, 1986 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 16, 1990 - Found cast iron monument in flower garden and updated ties.

August 8, 1994 - Found cast iron monument in flower garden and updated ties.

November 16, 2000 - Found cast iron monument 1'± west of Cedar tree base and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

March 23, 2010 - Found cast iron monument in flower garden and updated ties.
