

AND on the <u>18th</u> day of <u>February</u>, <u>2021</u>, said permanent marker was <u>found down 0.1' \pm and</u> the ties were updated

CORNER HISTORY:

February 1855 - This corner was established by Hiram Taylor, Deputy Surveyor. Taylor marked the position by "Set quarter section post" with two bearing trees marked as accessories.

February 13, 1961 - Found 1/2" iron pipe up 1' between fence posts (fence lines run east west and north). Updated ties.

July 17, 1964 - Found iron pipe and updated ties.

June 17, 1971 - Found iron pipe and replaced with a cast iron monument flush using corner ties. Updated ties.

June 9, 1975 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 9, 1978 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

November 7, 1990 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 27, 1996 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

September 5, 2001 - Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

March 23, 2011 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties. Set sign and post on east side 5/4/11.

February 15, 2017 - Found cast iron monument down 0.1'± and updated ties.

February 18, 2021 - Found cast iron monument down 0.1'± and updated ties. Verified position by VRS GPS methods.
