
INDEX 755 Page No. 62 CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION OF GOVERNMENT CORNER County of Anoka State of Minnesota <u>West 1/4 Corner of Sec. 14 Township 32 Range 23</u> On the <u>2nd</u> day of <u>November</u>, 1966, the described corner was evidenced by <u>area resurvey</u> and to perpetuate the location of said corner, at the exact location thereof, a permanent marker was placed consisting of <u>a red and white 2</u>" square steel Telespar monument with a sign <u>attached to the south side</u> AND on the <u>12th</u> day of <u>April</u>, 2021, said permanent marker was <u>found w/2</u>" sq. steel Telespar mont, up 2.5'± w/punchmarked "Co. Surveyor" cap. Updated ties.

## **CORNER HISTORY:**

February 1855 - This corner was established by Hiram Taylor, Deputy Surveyor. Taylor marked the position by "Set quarter section post" with one bearing tree marked as an accessory.

November 2, 1966 - Set 1-1/4" red and white iron pipe up 3'± using area resurvey. Established tie to pipe.

May 17, 1971 - Found 1-1/4" red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

July 17, 1975 - Found 1-1/4" red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

June 13, 1978 - Found 1-1/4" red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

June 29, 1984 - Found 1-1/4" red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

May 20, 1992 - Found old 1-1/4" red and white iron pipe and replaced with a new red and white iron pipe. Updated ties.

August 21, 1996 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

September 4, 2001 - Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

March 24, 2011 - Found 2" square red and white steel Telspar monument with sign attached (set date unknown). Updated ties to Telspar monument.

February 16, 2017 - Found 2" square red and white steel Telspar monument in need of reset.

August 17, 2017 - Found 2" square red and white steel Telspar monument with top broken off, Bottom of monument found 0.3'± below water level in ditch and leaning.

September 18, 2017 - Replaced broken Telspar base with a new 2" x 2" x 8' steel Telspar monument with punchmarked cap up 2.5'±. Verified position by VRS GPS methods. Updated ties. Set sign and post on south side.

April 12, 2021 - Found 2" square steel Telspar monument with punchmarked cap up 2.5' ± w/ sign and post on the South Side. Updated Ties. Verified position of corner by VRS GPS method.
