


Updated reference ties are as shown below.



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HISTORY OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

County of Anoka

State of Minnesota

<u>West 1/4</u> Corner of Sec. <u>24</u> Township <u>32</u> Range <u>23</u>

CORNER HISTORY:

February 1855 - This corner was established by Hiram Taylor, Deputy Surveyor. Taylor marked the position by "Set quarter section post" with one bearing tree marked as an accessory.

December 2, 1965 - Set 1" red and white iron pipe up 3'± using area resurvey. Established ties to iron pipe.

January 21, 1974 - Found 1" red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

March 10, 1987 - Found red and white iron pipe and replaced with a cast iron monument flush. Set sign and post on the north side. Updated ties.

September 4, 1996 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

February 12, 2002 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties. Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

March 31, 2011 - Found cast iron monument up 0.5'± and leaning northeasterly. Checked corner ties.

April 14, 2011 - Found cast iron monument and checked position by static GPS methods.

May 23, 2011 - Removed cast iron monument and replaced with a 2" square steel Telspar monument w/punch marked 'County Surveyor' cap up 0.4'±. Verified position by VRS GPS methods. Updated ties.

March 13, 2017 - Found 2" square steel Telspar monument w/punch marked 'County Surveyor' cap up 0.4'± and updated ties.

April 5, 2021 - Found 2" square steel Telspar monument w/punch marked 'County Surveyor' cap up 0.4'± and updated ties.
