

CORNER HISTORY:

February 1855 - This corner was established by Hiram Taylor, Deputy Surveyor. Taylor marked the position by "Set quarter section post" with two bearing trees marked as accessories.

November 18, 1975 - Set cast iron monument using area resurvey. Established ties to monument. Set sign and post on the north side.

June 19, 1978 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

January 25, 1991 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

February 14, 2002 - Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

April 14, 2011 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

March 24, 2017 - Found cast iron monument down 0.2'± and updated ties.

April 5, 2021 - Found cast iron monument down 0.2'± and updated ties.
