

CORNER HISTORY:

February 1855 - This corner was established by Hiram Taylor, Deputy Surveyor. Taylor marked the position by "Set quarter section post" with two bearing trees marked as accessories.

August 7, 1969 - Set cast iron monument up 0.1'± using area resurvey. Established ties to monument.

November 1972 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties. Set sign and post on north side.

June 23, 1975 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 20, 1978 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 11, 1984 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

November 26, 1991 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

December 12, 2001 - Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

April 16, 2013 - Found cast iron monument up 0.1'± and updated ties.

February 7, 2017 - Found cast iron monument up 0.1'± and updated ties.
