

HISTORY OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

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County of Anoka

State of Minnesota

Northeast Corner of Sec. 33 Township 32 Range 23

CORNER HISTORY:

February 1855 - This corner was established by Hiram Taylor, Deputy Surveyor. Taylor marked the position by "Set post corner to sections 27, 28, 33 & 34" with one bearing tree marked as an accessory.

August 31, 1955 - F.C. Jackson found a granite monument up 1'± and 7' west of a fence line. Updated the ties.

July 23, 1964 - Found granite monument up 1'± and updated ties.

August 4, 1966 - Found granite monument and updated ties.

June 23, 1971 - Found granite monument and updated ties.

June 20, 1975 - Found granite monument and updated ties.

December 10, 1975 - Replaced granite monument with a red and white iron pipe up 2.5'±. Updated ties.

June 20, 1978 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

July 11, 1984 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

July 14, 1987 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

January 29, 1991 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

November 26, 1991 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

August 13, 1996 - Found red and white iron pipe and updated ties.

December 12, 2001 - Found red and white iron pipe w/sign and updated ties. Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

March 8, 2011 - Found red and white iron pipe leaning southwesterly 0.8'±. Set temporary point and checked ties.

March 31, 2011 - Set 2" square by 6' steel Telspar monument with punch marked 'County Surveyor' cap up 0.5'± using static GPS methods. Verified position by VRS GPS methods. Updated ties.

February 7, 2017 - Found 2" square steel Telspar monument w/cap up 0.5'±. Updated ties.

April 6, 2021 - Found 2" square steel Telspar monument w/cap up 0.5'±. Updated ties.
