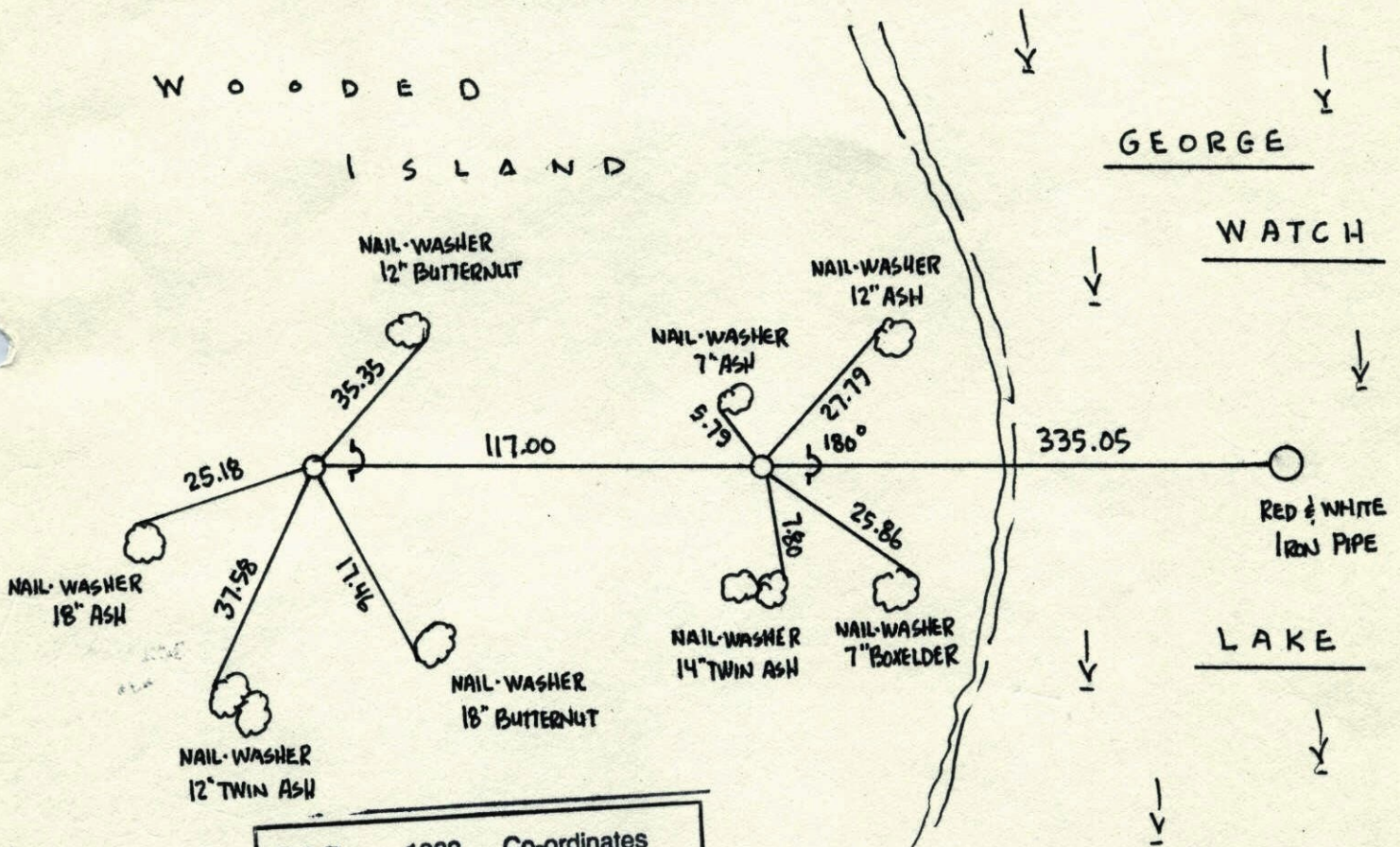

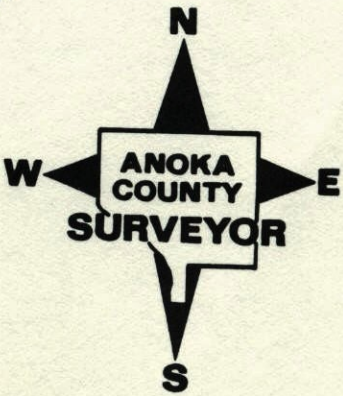
and I further certify that to perpetuate the location of said corner, I did, at the exact location thereof, place a permanent marker consisting of RED & WHITE IRON PIPE

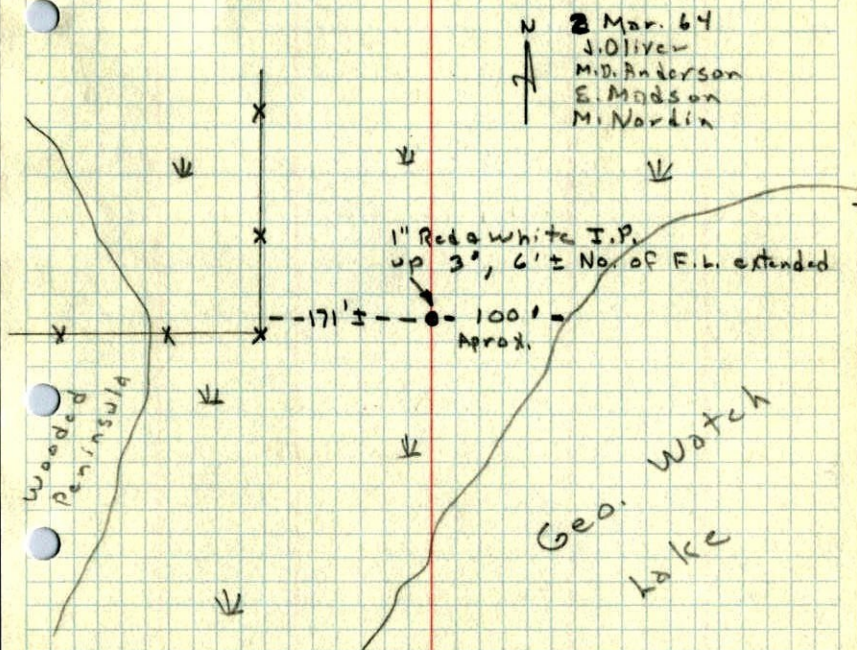
