

CORNER HISTORY:

December 30, 1944 — Cartwright set Concrete Monument up $4^{"}\pm$ on south line of Section 19 using southwest corner of section and a stake on south line from 1918 survey records.. Established ties to monument.

February 6, 1964 – Found 4" square Concrete Monument up $0.5'\pm$ and updated ties.

August 21, 1969 - Concrete Monument not found.

July 3, 1973 - Concrete Monument not found.

September 20, 1974 — Replaced Concrete Monument with Cast Iron Monument set flush with the surface and updated ties. Set sign and post on north side of monument.

May 25, 1977 - Found Cast Iron Monument and updated ties.

August 14, 1980 - Found Cast Iron Monument and updated ties.

January 3, 1997 — Found Cast Iron Monument with sign and post on the north side and updated ties.

Revision Date 2/03/11 – Found Cast Iron Monument and updated ties.

January 30, 2017- Found Cast Iron Monument laying down - needs to be reset.
