


HISTORY OF GOVERNMENT CORNER

County of Anoka

State of Minnesota

North 1/4 Corner of Sec. <u>3</u> Township <u>33</u> Range <u>25</u>

CORNER HISTORY:

September 1849 - This corner was established by Theodore Conkey, Deputy Surveyor. Conkey marked the position by "set post for quarter section corner" with two bearing trees marked as accessories.

November 18, 1974 - Set cast iron monument using area resurvey. Established ties to monument. Set sign and post on northwest side.

July 14, 1976 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 24, 1979 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 5, 1982 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 15, 1985 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 16, 1989 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 11, 1994 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

December 11, 2002 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties. Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

April 17, 2013 - Found cast iron monument w/sign missing and updated ties. Set new sign and post on the northwest side (8/1/2014).

February 22, 2018 - Found cast iron monument flush w/sign and post on the northwest side. Verified position by VRS GPS methods. Updated ties.

July 7, 2021 - Found cast iron monument flush w/sign and post on the northwest side. Updated ties.
