
# South 1/4 Corner of Sec. 4 Township 33 Range 25

On the <u>2nd</u> day of <u>December</u>, <u>1974</u>, the described corner was evidenced by <u>area resurvey</u>

and to perpetuate the location of said corner, at the exact location thereof, a permanent marker was placed consisting of <u>a cast iron monument with a sign and post  $1.25'\pm$  north of monument</u>

AND on the <u>28th</u> day of <u>December</u>, <u>2017</u>, said permanent marker was <u>found flush and the</u> ties were updated

#### **CORNER HISTORY:**

May 1855 - This corner was established by James M. Marsh, Deputy Surveyor. Marsh marked the position by "set quarter section post" with two bearing trees marked as accessories.

December 2, 1974 - Set cast iron monument using area resurvey. Established ties to monument. Set sign and post on north side.

July 16, 1976 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 17, 1979 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 4, 1982 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 14, 1989 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 5, 1994 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 29, 2002 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

December 7, 2002 - Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

March 26, 2013 - Found cast iron monument flush w/sign and post 1.25'± north of monument. Verified position by VRS GPS methods. Updated ties.

December 28, 2017 - Found cast iron monument flush and updated ties.
