

#### **CORNER HISTORY:**

May 1855 - This corner was established by James M. Marsh, Deputy Surveyor. Marsh marked the position by "set quarter section post" with one bearing tree marked as an accessory.

June 15, 1966 - Set red and white iron pipe up 3'± using area resurvey. Iron pipe is at intersection of old fence lines. Established ties to iron pipe.

July 22, 1969 - Found red and white pipe and updated ties.

July 31, 1973 - Found red and white pipe and updated ties.

July 28, 1976 - Found red and white pipe and updated ties.

July 23, 1979 - Found red and white pipe and updated ties.

August 3, 1982 - Found red and white pipe and updated ties.

June 22, 1987 - Found red and white pipe and updated ties.

September 8, 1988 - Found red and white pipe and updated ties.

July 18, 1994 - Found red and white pipe and updated ties.

February 20, 2003 - Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.
