
<u>West 1/4</u> Corner of Sec. <u>2</u> Township <u>33</u> Range <u>24</u>

On the <u>25th</u> day of <u>October</u>, <u>1973</u>, the described corner was evidenced by <u>area resurvey</u>

and to perpetuate the location of said corner, at the exact location thereof, a permanent marker was placed consisting of <u>a red and white iron pipe with a sign attached</u>

AND on the <u>19th</u> day of <u>November</u>, <u>2020</u>, said permanent marker was <u>found with a sign</u> <u>attached and the ties were updated</u>.

CORNER HISTORY:

October 25, 1973 - Set red and white iron pipe w/sign attached using area resurvey. Established ties to pipe.

January 18, 1978 - Found red and white iron pipe w/sign attached and updated ties.

July 6, 1992 - Found red and white iron pipe w/sign attached and updated ties.

June 17, 1997 - Found red and white iron pipe w/sign attached and updated ties.

March 28, 2001 - Found red and white iron pipe w/sign attached and updated ties. Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

September 8, 2011 - Found red and white iron pipe w/sign broken off. Verified position by VRS GPS methods. Updated ties. Replaced sign 3/30/2012.

March 31, 2017 - Found red and white iron pipe w/sign. Verified position by VRS GPS methods. Updated ties.

November 19, 2020 - Found red and white iron pipe w/sign. Updated ties.
