

1963 - N.C. Hoium found a iron pipe and updated ties.

August 2, 1973 - Reset corner using remaining ties. Set 2 cast iron monuments one on top of the other due to the area residents habit of removing corners. Updated ties. Set warning sign and post.

November 1, 1984 - Reset cast iron monument down 1'± using area resurvey. Updated ties.

June 12, 2002 - Established NAD 1983 (1996 adj.) Anoka County project coordinates by static GPS methods.

February 22, 2012 - Found cast iron monument down 0.5'± and updated ties.

April 10, 2017 - Found cast iron monument down 0.5'± and updated ties.

December 11, 2020 - Found cast iron monument down 0.5'±. Verified position by VRS GPS methods. Updated ties.
