

CORNER HISTORY:

June 13, 1961 — N.C. Hoium and Associates, Inc. found notched field stone. Set 1/2" iron pipe on north side of stone and established ties to monument.

June 17, 1963 — Found notched field stone using N.C. Hoium and Associates, Inc. ties and updated ties. Set 3/4" iron pipe underneath field stone.

August 10, 1964 — Found notched field stone with 3/4" iron pipe on north side of stone and updated ties.

June 18, 1969 — Found notched field stone with 3/4" iron pipe on north side of stone and updated ties.

July 25, 1972 — Found notched field stone with 3/4" iron pipe on north side of stone and updated ties. Stone is $4'\pm$ east and $5'\pm$ south of fences.

July 3, 1979 — Found notched field stone with 3/4" iron pipe on north side of stone and updated ties.

August 18, 1982 — Found notched field stone with 3/4" iron pipe on north side of stone and updated ties.

July 31, 1985 — Found notched field stone with 3/4" iron pipe on north side of stone and updated ties.

July 5, 1988 — Found notched field stone with 3/4" iron pipe underneath the stone and updated ties.

August 23, 1993 — Found notched field stone with 3/4" iron pipe underneath the stone and updated ties.

March 2, 2000 — Found notched field stone and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties. Also found sign and post on south side of stone, date set unknown.

June 9, 2010 - Found notched field stone with 3/4" iron pipe underneath the stone and with a sign and post on the south side. Updated ties.

September 28, 2015 — Found notched field stone with a 1/2" iron pipe on the north side of stone and a sign and post on the south side. Updated ties.

June 10, 2020 — Found notched field stone with a 1/2" iron pipe on the north side of stone and a sign and post on the south side. Updated ties.

September 26, 2022 — Found notched field stone with a 1/2" iron pipe on North side of stone, verified position by VRS GPS method and updated ties.
