


and to perpetuate the location of said corner, at the exact location thereof, a permanent marker was placed consisting of <u>a cast iron monument</u>

## **CORNER HISTORY:**

February 9, 1966 - Set cast iron monument using area resurvey and established ties to monument.

June 10, 1969 – Found cast iron monument up  $0.1'\pm$  and updated ties.

August 16, 1972 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 21, 1976 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

June 18, 1979 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 18, 1982 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

July 15, 1988 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

August 20, 1993 - Found cast iron monument and updated ties.

February 15, 2000 — Found cast iron monument with sign and post on the south side and established NAD 1983 (1996 Adjustment) Anoka County Project Coordinates by Static GPS methods. Updated ties.

May 20, 2010 - Found cast iron monument up  $0.3'\pm$  with sign and post on the south side and updated ties.

September 30, 2015 - Found cast iron monument up  $0.3'\pm$  with sign and post on the south side and updated ties.

June 1, 2020 - Found cast iron monument up  $0.3'\pm$  with sign and post on the south side and updated ties.

September 29, 2022 — Found cast iron monument up 0.3' $\pm$ , verified position by VRS GPS method and updated ties.
